Park safely to keep our community safe

Parking on a footpath, nature strip or roadside verge poses a risk to pedestrians and other drivers.

When cars are parked illegally, it can be dangerous for vulnerable members of our community including children, people who are visually impaired and those using a wheelchair or pram.

Parking illegally can also damage trees, footpaths, gutters and underground pipes and cables.

Parking inspectors regularly patrol our suburbs to support safe parking.







You can be fined for parking a vehicle:



On a footpath



On a nature strip or roadside verge



On the wrong side of the road and not in the direction of travel
