

2024 CLEARANCE / PERMIT PROCESS



Registered Players of the CRRL may transfer between Clubs. A request for clearance or permit must be commenced by the receiving Club or Player via entering a clearance request via the Mysideline database. The Club they were with the previous year in the process below is the Home Club and the Club they wish to move to is the Prospective Club.

It is advised that the player or their parent/guardian makes contact with their Home club and their Prospective club to discuss their application.

Players must register with the Prospective Club via Mysideline. This will automatically generate a clearance/permit request. This can be done even if the Player has already registered with the home club for the current season.

If it is an application within the same region, then there are three approvals required.

- 1. Home Club
- 2. Prospective Club &
- 3.CRRL

Each Club then assesses the request and if it is approved, then each Club then marks it approved.

The CRRL does not action on any clearance unless it is in a direct violation of the Rules or until the Home Club actions it.

If it is approved, then the CRRL will mark it as such and complete the process. The player will now be able to be seen by their Prospective Club. If it is declined, then the CRRL will mark it as such and complete the process. The player will remain at the Home Club.

If both Player/Parent/Guardian & The Club believe there are extenuating circumstances that were not previously communicated, then they can apply to Appeal this decision. Please note that this appeal must be requested within 7 days of the decision being made. Please see CRRL Appeal process.

If it is an application is for a Club in another region or state, then there are up to 7 levels of approvals required. (may be more if part of a representative squad)

- 1. Home Club
- 2. Prospective Club
- 3. Home Association
- 4. Prospective Association
- 5. Regional &
- 6. State

Each Club then assesses the request and if it is approved, then each Club then marks it approved. The CRRL does not action on any clearance unless it is in a direct violation of the Rules until the Home Club actions it or one of the high levels declines it first.

If it is approved, then the CRRL will mark it as such and complete the process. The player will now be able to be seen by their Prospective Club.

If it is declined, then the CRRL will mark it as such and complete the process. The player will remain at the Home Club.

If both Player/Parent/Guardian & The Club believe there are extenuating circumstances that were not previously communicated, then they can apply to Appeal this decision. Please note that this appeal must be requested within 7 days of the decision being made. Please see CRRL Appeal process.
